

In October 2016, ~~we~~the authors conducted a quantitative survey targeting humanities students of a ~~certain~~particular public university in Fukuoka Prefecture, and in this survey, asked about the following: 1) Internet usage. 2) Whether they have computer skills and basic computer knowledge. 3) Wireless Local Area Network (LAN-) usage. 4) Level of ~~understanding of~~ internet risk on the Internet. ~~awareness.~~ 5) ~~Past~~Experience of past incidents. 6) Reasons they are not proactive in learning about internet security. Based on the survey findings ~~from this survey~~, in July 2019, we revised the ~~content~~ curriculum of an internet information security lecture toward freshmen first-year students at this university. This present paper measures the effectiveness of our revised educational program, and discusses potential for further revision. To state the conclusion first, the effect of the revision could be clearly seen. ~~Compared to~~For example, comparing students who received the lecture before the revision, ~~for the students with those~~ who received the revised lecture, the following tendencies were observed: 1) Sounder practice of computer security measures. 2) A tendency to avoid connecting to public wireless LANs without careful thought. 3) The number of students victimized defrauded by adware or browser hijackers decreased. 4) The number of students involved in social network services (SNS) related ~~troubles~~problems decreased.
